
How to Refill a Prescription

- Most pharmacies have options to also refill in person, text, and online. Check with your pharmacy. You can also bring your bottle to the pharmacy for easy refills.
- Keep your prescription bottle. Provide <u>Rx number</u> to pharmacy when asked.
- This is the number of refills left.
- When you are down to only 7 days of medication left, you can either <u>call or</u> <u>visit your pharmacy</u> and request a refill.



- Your pharmacy will contact your primary care doctor or nurse practitioner's office to request additional refills if needed.
- If there is a problem with your insurance call:

- prescription or your medication is not covered by your health insurance, call your doctor or clinic: 1M clinic 628-206-8494

- Make sure to request your medicine at the DROP-OFF in the GREEN line first! And then PICK-UP your medicine from the BROWN line.
